

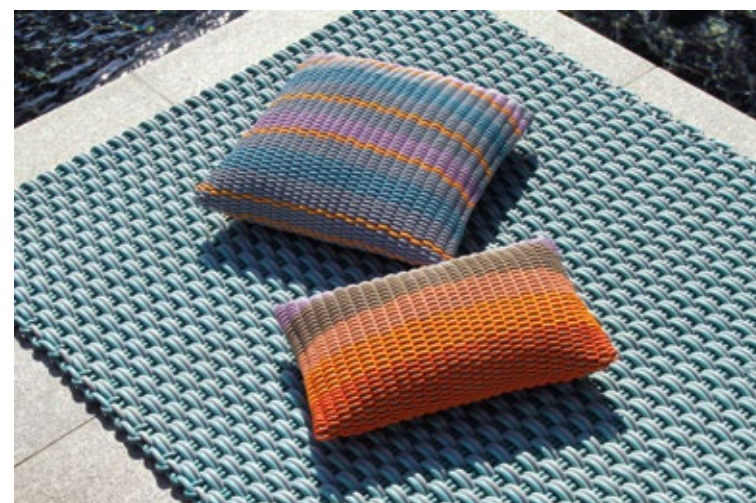

Outdoor rugs

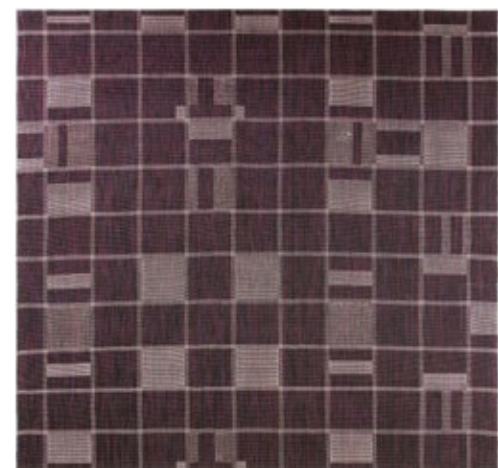

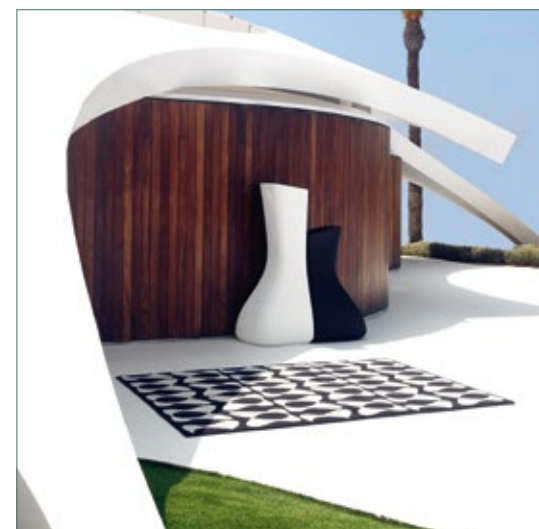

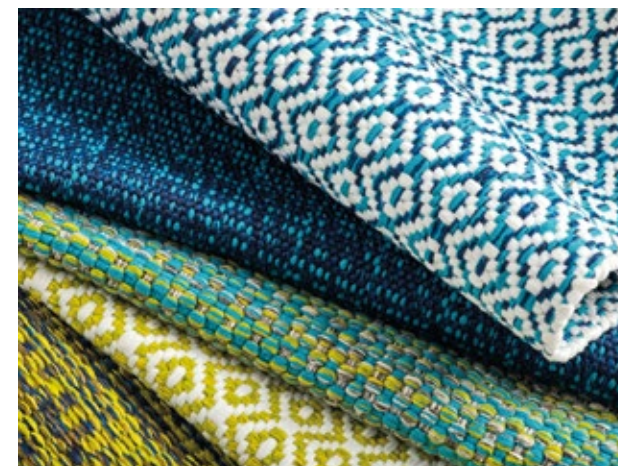
