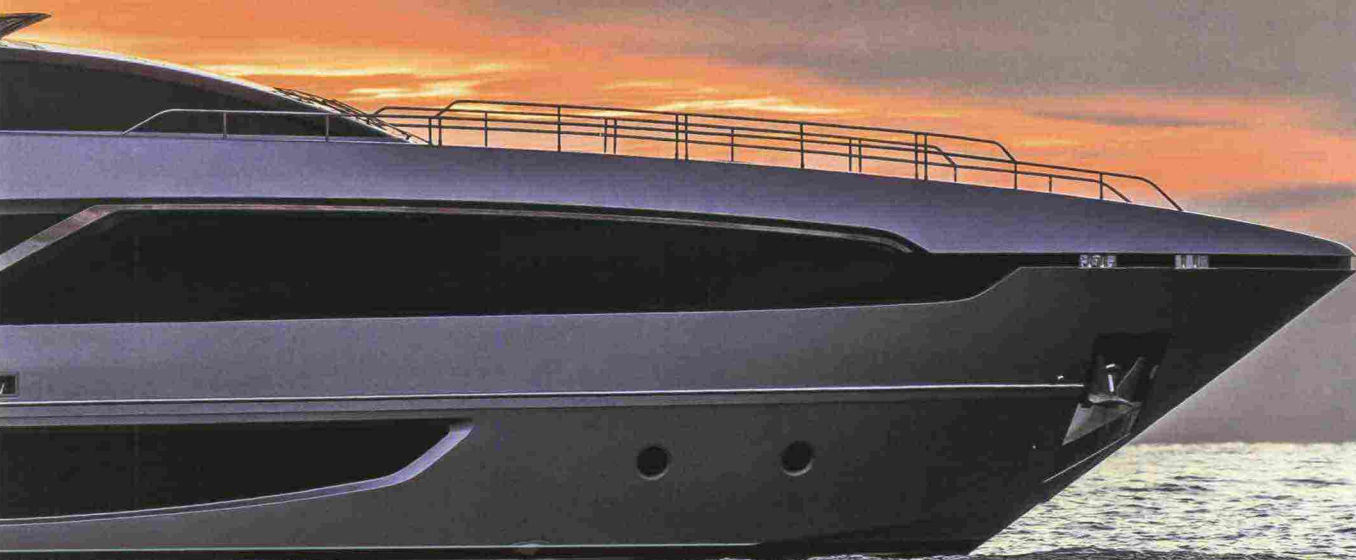


INNER BEAUTY

The interiors of Riva 100' Corsaro are a masterpiece
within the masterpiece, with top
Italian names that really bring out the best of them





GREAT YACHTS, LIKE GREAT PEOPLE, HAVE SOMETHING SPECIAL INSIDE THEM. IT IS ALREADY WELL ESTABLISHED THAT THE EXTERIOR OF THE RIVA 100' CORSARO IS TRULY BREATHTAKING, but it also features magnificent style and furnishings inside thanks to the joint efforts of Officina Italiana Design, the Product Strategy Committee and Engineering Department of the Ferretti Group. Starting on the main deck, the cockpit boasts a large outdoor table, a long stern sofa and three sophisticated Seax chairs by Dedon with armrests covered with wood. The structural sofas and sun pads on the exterior of the yacht are all covered with Mambo Pearl Light technical fabric in silver and platinum hues, which wonderfully complement the metallic tones and the teak flooring. On the main deck, striped walnut wood appears alongside polished stainless steel frames, white and Seal Brown matt lacquer inserts and large amounts of dark brown leather, which covers the ceilings, the bulwarks and a number of items of furniture, such as the custom-made coffee table in the lounge. Looking down over the latter is an ecru L-shaped Andersen sofa by Minotti with dulce-coloured Hermès cashmere cushions scattered on it. The two Brooklyn Chairs by Poltrona Frau are a scarlet hue. An unmistakable Flos table lamp rounds off the interior design in the living area. The curtains on the large glass door at the stern and the side windows are by Zimmer + Rohde. A refined touch is added to the formal dining area by the magnificent Calacatta marble flooring, on top of which stands a large Acerbis International table with a glass top surrounded by eight cream Fitzgerald chairs by Poltrona Frau. Beyond the lounge, the large starboard kitchen with a dinette boasts Miele appliances - including a Teppanyaki grill and a wine fridge - and a GE side-by-side refrigerator. The wide-body owner's suite

takes up the entire forward section of the deck. The main interior design features are the same as in the lounge: striped walnut wood, dark brown leather, white lacquer and polished stainless steel.

A stylish red leather Hermès chair is found next to the vanity unit, whose chest of drawers opens up to reveal a mirror and a number of storage compartments. Adorning the central double bed are pillows, a bedspread and a blanket by Ivano Redaelli and a dulce-coloured Hermès cashmere cushion. The bed faces a mirrored wall with a TV screen. The taps in the Master head are by Elka and the accessories by Pomd'Or. The same decorative approach is found in the bathrooms below deck. The only difference is the marble, which is Amani Brown in the guest heads. At the entrance to the main area below deck is a large lobby with a mirrored wall and ample storage compartments. It opens up onto the four guest cabins: two stern VIP cabins, a forward double cabin on the left and a twin cabin to starboard. The interior design scheme is the same as on the main deck. The soft decor is very sophisticated: a leather Hermès ottoman provides somewhere to sit in front of the vanity unit. There is a storage compartment hidden under the seat, which has a shape reminiscent of a saddle. An Ivano Redaelli bedspread and pillows add a decorative touch to the bed. The hard top protects the central part of the panoramic deck, which has a dining area on the left. The table is surrounded by an L-shaped structural sofa and 3 Seax outdoor chairs by Dedon, with wooden armrests. All of the furniture in the panoramic cockpit is freestanding and by Paola Lenti: two Sand lounge chairs and two Orlando sofas with moveable backrests in an L-shape are complemented by six decorative cushions and three Strap aluminium outdoor side tables in an aquamarine hue. The finishing touches are added by silver and aquamarine floor and table Agadir lanterns.

Adjoining page, the interiors: top to bottom, a VIP cabin; the lower deck lobby; the galley; the wide body Master suite and its private head enriched with dark marble, Elka and Pomd'or accessories; the raised pilot house and the panoramic cockpit at night. Centre of the page, the main deck lounge, a real collection of state-of-the-art Italian furniture.
